Girls

Accessories

- single-hole earrings that are either a small stud or hoop
- Tennis shoes only
- Hair color can only be a natural color
- No makeup in Elementary
- Socks must be worn at all times

Uniforms

- (purchased through the Dennis Uniform company) is required Monday - Thursday unless your student has a Free Dress Pass that day.
- . Polo shirts do not have to be tucked in but first two buttons must be buttoned at all times. Undershirts may not show around the waist and must be white or the same color as the polo.
- Skirts and shorts must be at the knee.
- Navy school pants are allowed as part of the uniform only.
- School sweater, school jackets, or school sweatshirt may be worn on cold days.
Sweatshirts and jackets must be school-issued.

Non-Uniform Days

- Clothing must be clean and not torn
- Any dress, skirt, or shorts must reach the knee or leggings must be worn underneath.
- If leggings are worn, the top must cover to mid -thigh
- Undergarments must be worn at all times but not visible
- All straps must be at least two inches wide
- Clothing must not have hateful words or pictures
- Sports Uniforms only after 12 pm on game days.
- Tennis shoes and socks worn at all times

Boys

Hair

- hair must touch the collar of the shirt at the longest length
- Must be cut at the middle of the ears or above the eyebrows
- otherwise worn in a ponytail or bun at all times
- must be a natural color

Uniforms

- (purchased through the Dennis Uniform company) is required Monday - Thursday unless your student has a Free Dress Pass that day.
- . Polo shirts do not have to be tucked in but the first two buttons must be buttoned at all times. Undershirts may not show around the waist and must be white or the same color as the polo.
- Pants and shorts must be navy blue.
- Must be worn at waist level and not baggy or saggy.
- **Sweatshirts and jackets must be school-issued.**

Non-Uniform Days

- Clothing must be clean and not torn
- Undergarments must be worn at all times but not visible
- Clothing must not have hateful words or pictures
- Sports Uniforms only after 12 pm on game days.
- Tennis shoes and socks worn at all times
- No baseball caps or hats indoors and only for sun protection outside.
